Friday 1st – Saturday 9th November

Sunday 10th – Saturday 16th November

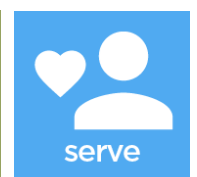

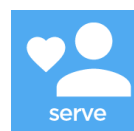
