## PRAYER for JOY 2020

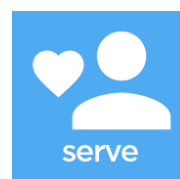


*God of life and hope,

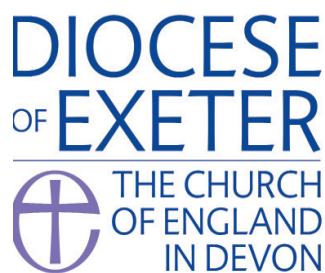
